
We make investing in Ukraine transparent and secure. We develop tools that help investors protect their investments.





We strive to create the best conditions in Ukraine for doing business and attracting investments. An entrepreneur city instead of a bureaucrat city.





- Increasing the autonomy of buildings (houses)



We believe that communities and businesses in post-war Ukraine should receive new financial instruments for the fastest reconstruction of the economy.


- Attracting grants and investments
